# MEDICAL \*\*

During this quarter MESCO supported 33 beneficiaries under Life Saving Medical Aid scheme for the major surgeries, chemotherapy and high cost medicines treatment taking place in government hospitals. Monthly medicines were provided to the 60 patients suffering from chronic ailments and 20 patients were assisted for the minor surgeries and diagnostic test under Medical Aid Scheme, 27 dialysis patients have been supported under Six Months Dialysis Scheme and 10 beneficiaries under Sustained Dialysis Support Scheme.

Forth coming event - 6 months Dialysis Scheme form distribution on 3<sup>rd</sup> September, 2023.



MESCO organized **Free Medical Camp** at Govandi area on 30<sup>th</sup> April, 2023 in association with Vimla Eye Hospital and HLL Maha Lab. The camp included free Medical consultation, free Eye Check-up, free blood tests (includes CBC, thyroid, sugar, lipid profile, renal profile, SGOT,

SGPT). Multivitamins and De-worming medicines were provided free of cost to the needy patients. 170 patients were assessed, advised and counseled. 145 patients were screened for their eye problem, eye glasses were provided to 123 patients at the rate of Rs. 120/- only. 12 cataract patients were identified for surgery, they were referred to Pramukh Swami Eye Hospital, Chunabhatti. The free Health Check-up Camp organized by the MESCO was a huge success and of a great help to all the beneficiaries attended the camp.

# **GRATITUDE STORY**

Mr. Firoz was suffering from Chronic Obstructive Pulmonary Disease. He was on regular medication which was managed through various trusts, but dayby-day his health was deteriorating. He was under treatment at Nair hospital. In June 2023 he was advised for the Oxygen Concentrator as he was unable to breathe properly. Due to poor financial status, he was unable to afford the cost of oxygen Concentrator. He lives in the slums of Malad in rented house. Due to his critical health condition he was unable to work therefore his wife took the responsibilities of a family of 7 members. He approached MESCO for the medical assistance and received maximum amount from MESCO to purchase an Oxygen Concentrator machine which facilitate him to breathe properly and live a normal life. Patient and his wife are grateful to the donors of MESCO for the prompt financial support.

#### QUARTER FULL OF ACTIVITIES



During the reporting quarter, the clinic department provided quality primary care to 2729 patients at the Medical Aid Dispensary, Mumbra, Amrutnagar, and 292 patients at the Umair Khopekar Memorial Physiotherapy Centre, Umair Khopekar Memorial Clinic was reopened on 2<sup>nd</sup> May, 2023 at the premises of Umair Khopekar Memorial Physiotherapy Centre in evening shift (6:00 pm to 9:00 pm), since then 161 patients have received primary care. The clinic department sincerely thanks Mr. Sahir Khatib (VC, Medley Pharmaceuticals Ltd.) and Ms. Shabana Kazi for their in-kind donations of medicines.

# **& RELIEF OF POVERTY**

Relief of Poverty program aims to address various issues related to poverty. One of the initiatives under this program is the distribution of monthly ration kits to individuals and families in need who are unable to arrange their own food. We have been distributing ration to hundreds of families as a part of this program. Additionally, every quarter, we distribute sewing machines to enable women empowerment and help attain self-sufficiency.

#### **SEWING MACHINE DISTRIBUTION**

In the sewing machine distribution process, beneficiaries are required to call the MESCO office on monthly basis. They provide their names and details for the sewing machine. We collect this information and use a software based lottery system to select beneficiaries separately for zakat and non-zakat cases. Once selected, the beneficiaries undergo a trade test and a personal interview at our office. Finally, the chosen beneficiaries are called to the office to collect their sewing machines. Following is the statistics for the beneficiaries registered and selected for the sewing machine distribution program over the course of three months:

On June 24, 2023, the sewing machine distribution event took place at the MESCO, Mahim office. The event aimed to provide sewing machines to women in need. A total of 24 sewing machines were distributed during the event. This distribution aimed to empower women by enabling them to fend for their families and create an additional source of income. Mrs. Ali Qureshi, well-wisher from US, graced the event as the guest of honor.

#### RATION SUPPORT SCHEME

Under our Ration Support Scheme, we have distributed dry rations to 10 different areas, benefitting approximately 355 families. In addition, we provided ration support to the 34 elderly residents of Kaynaat Old Age Home in Uttan. In June, a total of 389 beneficiaries received ration support. This initiative aims to assist individuals who are unable to fulfill their basic needs by providing them with essential food items. MESCO is dedicated to helping these individuals and providing them with a path towards sustainable livelihood.
