## SUCCESS STORY



**Shinde Rohit Pramod**

Rohit Shinde comes from a humble family—his father is a BEST bus driver, his mother a homemaker, and he has a younger sister. Despite financial challenges, his family always supported his education.

After SSC in 2017, financial difficulties threatened his studies, but with determination, Rohit approached MESCO. Through the EAS Scheme, he received the support needed to continue his education.

He completed his Diploma in Civil Engineering from VJTI (2020) and his Degree from DMCE (2023). Today, he is working as a Civil Engineer in a multinational company.

Rohit's journey is a powerful example of how determination, family support, and timely help can turn dreams into reality.

## MEDICAL

- A Medical Camp was organized at Ansar Hall on 18th Jan 2026, benefiting 222 patients through free consultations, medical tests, and eye check-ups.
- Dialysis Form Distribution event was organized at Anjuman Islam, on 1st Mar 2026, where a total of 52 patients attended, and 32 were selected for assistance.



- World Kidney Day program and a Medical Camp were held at Mumbra on 29th Mar 2026, featuring an awareness session and free check-ups, benefiting 379 people.

- Sessions were conducted by Dr. Nikhil Shinde, Nephrologist & Humera Poonawala, dietician on Kidney health.

### Restoring Mobility, Renewing hope

Pankaj Yadav, a 33-year-old living in the slums of Malad, who is hearing and speech impaired by birth, had been suffering from varicose veins since September 2025, leaving him unable to walk. Belonging to a economically fragile family, with his father earning only Rs. 8,000 per month, the much-needed surgery was beyond their reach.

With timely support from MESCO, Pankaj underwent successful surgery. Today, he is recovering well and has regained his ability to walk. His family extends their heartfelt gratitude to MESCO for bringing back hope and mobility into Pankaj's life.
