As we step into the new year, we are pleased to share the final quarterly update of 2025—a year marked by meaningful milestones and collective achievements. This editorial highlights the key achievements of MESCO and MES in 2025.

MESCO's healthcare support was recognized by LTMG Hospital and Wockhardt Hospital for assisting needy patients during their treatment.

Our education initiatives reached historic milestones, with the Education Adoption Scheme (EAS) completing 50 years and the High-Cost Education Scheme (HCES) celebrating 25 years of student support.

Adding to these achievements, MES' Radiant English High School & Jr. College won the Star Education Awards 2025 for Best Infrastructure in School – Maharashtra (Thane), while MES' Crescent English High School & Jr. College secured 1st position in the Mukhyamantri Majhi Shala Sundar Shala Abhiyan, winning a ₹3 lakh prize after selection at Taluka and District levels.



SUCCESS STORY



Leena from Andheri lost her father during Standard XII and nearly gave up her studies due to family responsibilities. MESCO supported her education through the EAS, helping her regain confidence and skills.

After completing her BAF, she was selected by Motilal Oswal, rising from Executive to Team Mentor within five years. Today, she supports her family, is pursuing an MBA, and dreams of owning a home in Mumbai.

We wish her continued success and good health.

- During the quarter, medical aid was provided to **247** beneficiaries for **major treatments** and **surgeries**, **56** patients for **monthly medicines**, **47** patients for **minor treatments**, and 53 dialysis patients for their **dialysis expenses**.

- A **medical camp** held at Jafari School, Govandi on 5th October 2025 saw strong community participation, with **537** patients receiving **healthcare services**.



A Timely Intervention that Saved little Mizan's life



Master Mizan Ansari a 4-year-old from Bhiwandi was diagnosed with a serious kidney condition requiring urgent treatment costing ₹47,000, which his family could not afford. MESCO's timely support made the treatment possible. Today, Mizan is healthy and recovering well, and his family is deeply grateful to MESCO and the donor.

CLINICS

► In the last quarter, the MESCO Medical-Aid Dispensary at Amrut Nagar, Mumbra served **4580** patients with **primary medical care**, while the Umair Khopekar Memorial Physiotherapy Centre provided **physiotherapy** to **662** individuals.

► A **free medical check-up camp** held on 23rd November 2025 benefited **134** patients.

70 spectacles were distributed at subsidized rates, 61 blood samples were collected for preventive health screening, and **20** patients received physiotherapy.

RELIEF OF POVERTY

► **Sewing Machine Distribution:** Over the last three months, 182 beneficiaries registered for the program, out of which 75 were selected through a transparent lottery and interview process.

sewing machines were distributed on 5th October 2025 at Bandra Boys Urdu School, in the presence of esteemed guests and trustees, promoting livelihoods and self-reliance.

► **Monthly Ration Support:** This month through dry ration distribution across 10 areas, including 34 elderly residents of Kaynaat Old Age Home, Uttan.

► **Student Enrichment Activities:** Diwali Vacation Competitions including Mehndi, Writing, Drawing, and Best Out of Waste were organized to foster creativity and participation.



► **Sports & Physical Development:** Kickboxing sessions commenced for VIII & IX Std students, encouraging fitness, discipline, and self-confidence.

► **Educational Initiatives:** Expert lectures for X Std students are scheduled during December 2025 – January 2026 to support academic readiness.
