MESCO remains dedicated to transforming the lives of needy and deserving population through vital medical assistance. MESCO provided financial assistance to **140** patients under the LSMA scheme for high-cost treatments and surgeries in govt. hospitals. Under MA scheme, **80** patients were provided with monthly medicines, and **49** patients received assistance for minor surgeries and diagnostic tests. **37** dialysis patients were assisted for their Dialysis expenses.

GRATITUDE STORY



Yusra, a 13-year-old girl has been living with congenital hearing loss since birth. For years, she relied on a hearing aid to help her engage with the world around her, but after seven years, that aid finally stopped working. Her school teacher urgently emphasized for a new hearing aid, warning that without it, she would have to leave her regular school.

Her father, is a salesman at a ready-made dress shop in Govandi, earns around Rs. 11,000 monthly to support their family of five. With two children studying and a monthly rent of Rs. 4,500, their financial situation is very unstable.

Fortunately, MESCO provided complete medical assistance for the new hearing aid. With this support, she was able to return to school and continue her education without interruption.

The family is very grateful to the donors of MESCO for their timely help, Thanks to their generosity, she can now thrive in her studies and live a normal, fulfilling life.

CLINICS

During the past quarter, the Clinic Department at Medical-Aid Dispensary in Mumbra, Amrut Nagar, gave primary health care to **3739** patients. Additionally, the Umair Khopekar Memorial Physiotherapy Centre provided physiotherapy services to **336** patients. Notably, the centre has extended its operating hours until 8 p.m. from September 2024.

SEWING MACHINE DISTRIBUTION

Over the past three months, the sewing machine distribution program has seen significant progress. A total of **257** beneficiaries registered for this period, with **45** individuals selected via a transparent lottery system. These beneficiaries then participated in trade tests and personal interviews.

TRADE TEST

A trade test was held on 29th September 2024, at MESCO's Landmark Office. A total of **85** cases were reviewed (May 2024 to September 2024) and **54** beneficiaries were selected to receive sewing machines based on their performance in the test.



RATION SUPPORT SCHEME



The Ration Support Scheme continues to assist individuals experiencing economic hardships. This month, Dry Rations was distributed in **10** different areas, with an additional **34** elderly residents of the Kaynaat Old Age

Home in Uttan receiving support. A total of **459** beneficiaries have been supported through essential ration.
