Our Medical team organized a Breast Cancer Awareness talk by Dr. Almas Khan, and a Free Medical Check-Up Camp on 6th October 2024 under Charity Fest in Collaboration with Anjuman- I-Islam Saif Tyabji High School at the Anjuman School, Mumbai Central. Another Free Medical Check-up Camp was held at the Medical Aid Dispensary and Umair Khoekar Memorial Physiotherapy Centre in Mumbra. The medical camp was attended by 1022 patients.

To foster growth and empowerment among students, our Education team organized a residential Personality Development Camp for EAS & HCES graduating Girls & Boys in the month of December 2024.

On 29th October 2024, our Relief of Poverty department distributed 20 sewing machines to beneficiaries at Nadiadwala Villa, Versova. The event was graced by Ms. Warda Sajid Nadiadwala.

Under our School Adoption Program (SAP), the SAP team hosted the D.El.Ed. and SSC Felicitation Program on 9th October 2024 at R.C. Mahim Municipal Urdu School to motivate and appreciate the efforts of the students. In addition, to celebrate and preserve the essence of the Urdu language, an Urdu Day program was organized on 7th December 2024 at the same school.

QUARTER FULL OF ACTIVITIES

- Training for competitive examination has been started by MESCO at Sayeed House, every Saturday from 3:00 p.m. to 5:00 p.m.
- A residential Personality Development Camp was organized for EAS & HCES graduating girls from Sunday, 8th December 2024, to Tuesday, 10th December 2024, at the F.I.A.M.C. Bio-Medical Ethics Centre, Goregaon, and for graduating Boys from Tuesday, 31st December 2024, to Thursday, 2nd January 2025, at the Yusuf Meherally Centre, Panvel.



- On 6th October 2024, MESCO (under Charity Fest) in collaboration with Anjum-I-Islam organized a free medical check-up camp at Anjuman-I-Islam Saif Tyabji High School at the Anjuman School, Mumbai Central. A breast cancer awareness talk was conducted by Dr. Almas Khan focussing on educating people about the importance of early detection, prevention, and awareness regarding breast cancer.



- A total of **876** patients were benefitted from the services provided by the camp.

The camp provided a wide range of medical services, including basic health check-ups, blood sugar tests, dental, orthopedic, pediatric, gynecological, and ENT consultations, and dermatological consultations.

Overall, the event was a tremendous success, providing invaluable support and awareness to all participants. The collaboration between MESCO and Anjuman-I-Islam School showcased a commitment to community health and well-being.

SUCCESS STORY

Naveed Shahalam

Naveed's journey to success is truly inspiring. Coming from a humble background, he joined MESCO's Education Adoption Scheme (EAS) after completing his SSC. At the time, his father was a taxi driver, his mother a homemaker, and his younger brother still in school. Despite financial struggles, Naveed excelled in academics, completing his HSC in Commerce with distinction. However, life took an unexpected turn when he lost his father during the COVID-19 pandemic. Undeterred, Naveed persevered and earned his Bachelor's in Management Studies from Mulund College of Commerce and an MBA from Vivekanand Business School.



MESCO stood by him through thick and thin, supporting him from junior college to the completion of his MBA. Naveed began his professional journey as an Analyst at Nomura, where he worked for three years, and is now a Senior Associate at Morgan Stanley. Reflecting on his journey, Naveed says, "MESCO has been a guiding light and constant source of inspiration during my toughest times." Today, by the grace of Almighty, he is financially and emotionally stable, supports his family, and looks forward to a bright future.

MEDICAL

- During the quarter, the Medical department provided medical assistance to beneficiaries as under :
 - ▶ **230** Beneficiaries under the LSMA scheme for high-cost treatments and surgeries in govt. hospitals.
 - ▶ **46** patients under MA scheme were provided with monthly medicines.
 - ▶ **65** patients received assistance for minor surgeries and diagnostic tests.
 - ▶ **92** dialysis patients were assisted with their Dialysis expenses.

GRATITUDE STORY

A Second Chance- Gausiya's battle with Renal failure and MESCO's Lifeline

A 26-year-old Gausiya had dreams of a joyful wedding, but life took an unexpected turn when she was diagnosed with renal failure just before her marriage. Her health deteriorated rapidly, forcing her to cancel the wedding. Gausiya's family of six was already struggling. Her father, once the family's strength, was bedridden due to a stroke. With two younger siblings in college, the financial burden fell on her elder brother, a private driver who earned just Rs. 18,000 a month. Along with household expenses, the growing medical costs of both Gausiya and her father seemed impossible. But thanks to MESCO, Gausiya received financial support for her regular dialysis, which helped her stay on track with her treatment. Without this support, she would often miss her dialysis sessions, worsening her condition. Now, with MESCO's aid, Gausiya's health has stabilized, and she is grateful for the life-saving support from MESCO.

CLINICS

- In the last quarter, the Medical-Aid Dispensary in Mumbra, Amrut Nagar, provided primary medical care to **3984** patients.

In addition, the Umair Khopekar Memorial Physiotherapy Centre provided physiotherapy services to **508** patients.

- On 17th November 2024, a Free Check-up Camp was held at the Medical Aid Dispensary and Umair Khopekar Memorial Physiotherapy Centre in Amrut Nagar, Mumbra. The camp offered FREE Thyroid (TSH) test, Bone Mineral Density (BMD) test, Random Blood Sugar (RBS) test, and Physiotherapy check-up. A total of **146** patients participated in the camp, comprising **20** men and **126** women.

RELIEF OF POVERTY (ROP)

SEWING MACHINE DISTRIBUTION

The sewing machine distribution initiative has been a cornerstone of our efforts to empower individuals and families through skill development and economic support. This quarter, **255** beneficiaries were registered, out of which **75** were selected through a transparent lottery process.

- On 13th October 2024, at Bandra Boys Urdu School, **34** sewing machines were distributed. This event was graced by Ms. Rehana Dawood Vohra, donor and well-wisher; Dr. Afshan Laheji (president of IDA); and our esteemed MESCO trustees.

- **20** sewing machines were distributed on 29th October 2024, at Nadiadwala Villa, Versova. The event was attended by Ms. Warda Sajid Nadiadwala, Mr. Javed Khan, Ms. Arie Shaikh, and MESCO trustees.



These events were not just about distribution but also about celebrating the resilience and courage of the beneficiaries, who shared their challenges and expressed heartfelt gratitude to all donors.

RATION SUPPORT SCHEME

- The Ration Support Scheme continues to be a lifeline for many families facing economic hardship. This quarter, we continued to provide dry rations to individuals across **10** different areas, including the elderly residents of Kaynaat Old Age Home in Uttan.
- A total of **451** beneficiaries were supported, ensuring they had access to essential resources during these challenging times.

DISASTER RELIEF

Following the tragic BEST bus accident at Kurla Station, we have begun monthly ration support for two affected families one from Bandra and another from Ghatkopar starting January 2025. This initiative aims to provide essential food supplies and relief during their challenging times.

SCHOOL ADOPTION

- Students from IX and X standards performed a street play on the theme of Swachh Bharat Abhiyan, along with speeches, songs, and other activities on the occasion of Gandhi Jayanti at R.C. Mahim School.

- Medals, college bags, certificates, and prizes were awarded to students who scored 70% and above in the D.El.Ed and SSC Board examinations.

- On 14th November 2024, Children's Day was celebrated with great zeal along with the IX and X standard students at R.C. Mahim School.
- A writing competition was conducted on 3rd December 2024 for IV standard students of the Extra Coaching Class in the subjects of Urdu and English at R.C. Mahim School.

MES, CRESCENT ENGLISH HIGH SCHOOL

- On 1st, 3rd & 4th October 2024, an Eye Check-up Camp at MES' Crescent English High School & Jr. College was organized by the Giant Welfare Foundation. The camp served **1556** students and **50** staff members. Spectacles were provided at minimal rates to those in need.
